We've got some great events coming up to celebrate our history and the Purnim-Framlingham Aboriginal Reserve connection:

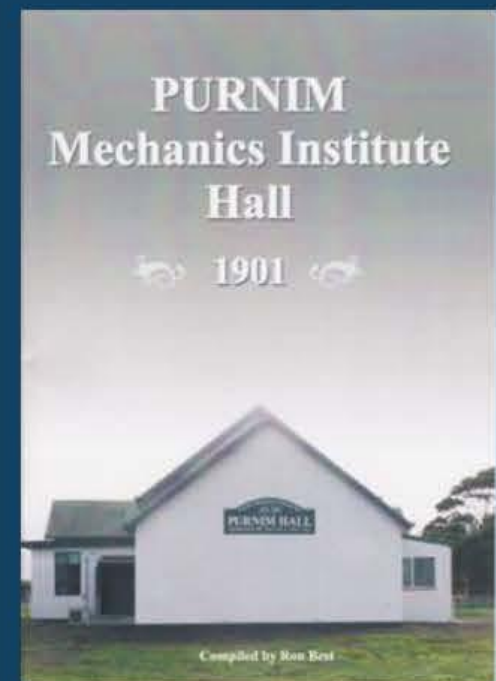
PURNIM HALL
